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CONSIDERATIONS

The search criteria reflects the Shingles National Immunisation Programme guidance as per the Greenbook Chapter 28a and has been developed by GSK in partnership with Interface Clinical Services. These search files have been created based on codes from the 2023-24 NHS Digital shingles vaccination programme business rules, change logs and expanded cluster list (last edited October 2023). These searches are designed to be used up until 31st August 2024 and will be updated annually.

The data provided from the searches is intended to support healthcare professionals (HCPs) in identifying patients which may be eligible for shingles vaccination on the Shingles National Immunisation Programme.

The system searches do not make clinical decisions and are not intended to replace individual clinical judgement of the HCP using the search outputs.

Clinical review is required of the lists created. The outputs are reliant on the accuracy of electronic health record (EHR) data and patient coding. The relevant Summary of Product Characteristics (SmPC) should be consulted when making treatment decisions for individual patient's management.

If eligible patients identified by the system searches are vaccinated, this will result in SHINGRIX usage. No patient data will be shared with GSK as a result of these searches.

The severely immunocompromised search provides a list of patients that:

- 1 Are aged 50 years or over on the search date
- Have clinical codes indicative of severely immunocompromised status
- Have not received a shingles vaccination in the past

The immunocompetent search provides a list of patients that:


- 1 Are either aged 70-79 years old within the vaccination period*
- 2 Have passed the age of 65 years within the vaccination period*
- Have not received a shingles vaccination in the past
- Do NOT have clinical codes indicative of severely immunocompromised status

*Vaccination period between 1/9/2023 and the date the search is run





IMPORTING THE SEARCHES INTO SYSTMONE

- 1. Navigate to the 'Reporting' option in the top ribbon and select 'Clinical Reporting'.
- 2. Select searches for import but clicking the 'Import' button and find the 'Shingles Vaccination System Searches for Patient Identification' you have downloaded.
- 3. Complete the import by ensuring the searches are logged under the correct category and subcategory within your organisations search hierarchy. Click 'OK' to finish the import.



RUNNING THE SEARCHES IN SYSTMONE

1. Select the green arrow button to run the searches, making sure all searches are selected (highlighted in blue) - A prompt will appear asking if you wish to run all reports. Select 'Yes'.

To re-select the searches, left-click on the first search in the list, hold down the Shift key on your keyboard and left-click the last search at the bottom of the list.)



VIEWING THE PATIENT LISTS IN SYSTMONE

- 1. Once the searches have run, select the report named '1. All Immunocompetent Patients Requiring Shingles Vaccination (2023/24)' by left clicking on it, then press the magnifying glass icon in the top ribbon.
- 2. You can either view the list of patients directly within SystmONE or you may wish to export this list for offline review. To do this there are a number of options available in the top ribbon including 'save all pages to CSV' and 'save all pages to RTF'.



Repeat the process of running the searches & viewing the patient list for '2. All Severely Immunocompromised - Requiring Shingles Vaccination (2023/2024)'.
